WORKSHOP ON "INTERNATIONALISATION AND EDUCATIONAL REFORMS: THE PATH TO EUROPEAN INTEGRATION" HELD ON 28 MARCH 2025

On 28 March 2025, the State Scientific Institution "Institute of Educational Analytics" (SSI "IEA"), the national unit of the Eurydice Network in Ukraine, held a workshop "Internationalisation and Educational Reforms: The Path to European Integration" within the Erasmus+ project *Eurydice Network in Ukraine: Access and Cooperation (ENUAC)*, with the support of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine (MESU). The event gathered government officials, international experts, researchers, and representatives of civil society to discuss Ukraine's integration into the European Education Area (EEA).

Opening remarks by Andrii Lytvynchuk (SSI "IEA"), Marko Skral (Government Office for Coordination of European and Euro-Atlantic Integration) and Peter Birch (European Education and Culture Executive Agency) emphasised the strategic role of education in European integration, especially in wartime, and highlighted the value of Ukraine's Eurydice Network membership since 2024.

The first panel addressed state policies for EU integration, with Oleksandra Husak (MESU) detailing the education and science negotiation process, bilateral screening, and the role of SSI "IEA" in providing key statistics. Andrii Lytvynchuk presented ENUAC achievements and plans for a new project *Eurydice Ukraine: Improving Education Accessibility (EU-IEA)*. Serhii Melnyk introduced Ukraine's participation in the Horizon Europe project *SKILLS4JUSTICE*.

A second panel focused on EU grant support, featuring the National Erasmus+Office, Europass, Euroguidance, EQF, eTwinning, and Horizon Europe offices. Speakers presented new initiatives, cooperation opportunities, and infrastructure development prospects. The final panel explored contributions of NGOs and researchers to European integration, with inputs from the Ukrainian Association of Teachers and Researchers of European Integration and Ukrainian Modern Digital Science.

The workshop served as a platform for sharing experiences, identifying challenges and opportunities, and defining key directions for aligning Ukraine's education system with the EEA. Such discussions are vital to ensuring that ongoing reforms meet EU standards. In the context of post-war recovery, these steps are not only about integration, but also about strengthening the resilience and competitiveness of the national system.
