

The VII International Conference "Harmonisation of the Ukrainian Education System with the European Education Area: Achievements, Challenges and Prospects" was held in Kyiv

On 30 October 2025, the VII International Scientific and Practical Conference "Harmonisation of the Ukrainian Education System with the European Education Area: Achievements, Challenges and Prospects" was held in Kyiv. The event took place within the framework of the Eurydice Ukraine: Improving Education Accessibility (EU-IEA) project, supported by the European Commission, and was hosted by the State Scientific Institution "Institute of Educational Analytics" (SSI "IEA"), the National Eurydice Unit in Ukraine.

The conference aimed to foster professional dialogue among representatives of the educational and research community on Ukraine's integration into the European Education Area. Key discussion topics included the harmonisation of education policy, ensuring access to education, digitalisation, innovation, international cooperation, as well as challenges related to wartime conditions and post-war recovery.

The opening session emphasised the symbolic significance of the conference, which coincided with the 45th anniversary of the Eurydice Network, and highlighted the practical importance of European integration for strengthening the resilience and sustainability of Ukraine's education system. The role of international partnership and continued support for Ukraine in advancing shared European values was also underscored.

The plenary sessions focused on current trends and strategic challenges in the development of Ukraine's education system. Discussions covered a wide range of issues, including human capital development, education financing, professional development of educators, digital transformation and the use of artificial intelligence, vocational education reform, and the European integration dimension of education policy. Particular attention was given to post-war recovery and the modernisation of education as a foundation for Ukraine's long-term development.

In summarising the conference outcomes, emphasis was placed on the importance of presenting Ukraine's experience within European initiatives and strengthening evidence-based policymaking. Attention was also drawn to the approval in July 2025 of the Roadmap for Harmonising Ukraine's Educational Statistics with EU Standards, developed with active involvement of the National Eurydice Unit in Ukraine.
